Ecologies of life and fellowship in Indian Ocean worlds

Smriti Srinivas' *Reimagining Indian Ocean Worlds* (2020) breaks new ground by bringing together multidisciplinary approaches to examine contemporary Indian Ocean worlds. It reconfigures the Indian Ocean as a space for conceptual and theoretical relationality based on social science and humanities scholarship, thus moving away from an area-based and geographical approach. Professor Srinivas' research interests include cities and urban cultures, religion, the body, South Asia within a comparative context, and Indian Ocean worlds.
